CABIN NOTES

- Cabin has one additional bed in the form of a single sofa bed
- $\hfill\square$ Cabin has one additional bed in the form of an upper pullman berth
- Cabin has two additional beds in the form of a double sofa bed
- ♦ Cabin has two additional beds in the form of upper pullman berths
- O Fixed twin beds
- Steel fronted balcony
- Overlooked by balconies above
- Cabin is partially shaded
- All adapted cabins have a shower only
- part obstructed view

Note:

All upper berths in twin cabins are accessible via a ladder. When upper berths are in use lower berths cannot be converted to a double.

Balconies in the forward section of the ship can be overlooked by the bridge.

BE Suites: D105 and D106 are large suites consisting of two bedrooms, two bathrooms with bath and shower, a lounge and a large balcony. These suites are suitable for sharing couples or families.

B5 Suites: Please note that suites L106 and L107 do not feature a dressing area, and they have a standard bath with a fixed shower attachment. They have a metal fronted balcony and a view over the observation deck area.
